Overview

The Ministry of Preschool and School Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan has commissioned m2r Education in partnership with SLC (Specialist Language Courses) to publicly recruit full-time English language teachers who are native-level English speakers. These teachers will be dispatched to public junior high and high schools across Uzbekistan to conduct English language education.

PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Classroom Teaching

Deliver engaging and communicative English language lessons to secondary school students while supporting the development of practical speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills.

Teachers are expected to conduct approximately **20 hours** of classroom instruction per week, including lesson planning, assessment, classroom management, and student progress monitoring.

A local assistant teacher will provide additional classroom support where applicable.

Extracurricular Activities

Lead weekly interactive extracurricular activities in designed to encourage language practice and student engagement outside the classroom environment.

Activities may include English clubs, conversation workshops, cultural exchange sessions, public speaking activities, academic competitions and seminars.

Teachers are expected to contribute approximately **6 hours** per week to extracurricular engagement activities.

Teacher Development and Collaboration

Teachers may also contribute to the professional development of local educators by participating in workshops, training sessions, and knowledge-sharing activities by contributing approximately 2 hours per week during the academic year.







These sessions provide opportunities for international collaboration and the exchange of modern teaching methodologies and classroom practices.

With a monthly salary ranging from USD 2000–3500, teachers in Uzbekistan can enjoy:

ACCOMMODATION AND SUPPORT

The program provides furnished single-occupancy accommodation for all teachers participating in the project.

Accommodation is generally located within reasonable proximity to the assigned workplace, typically within a distance of up to 5-7 km.

SUPPORT PROVIDED INCLUDES:

-  Work permit processing
-  Local registration assistance (*reimbursed by the Ministry*)
-  Airport pickup and domestic travel coordination (*reimbursed by the Ministry*)
-  Accommodation coordination (*reimbursed by the Ministry*)
-  Local onboarding support (*reimbursed by the Ministry*)
-  Assistance from program coordinators during settlement

Uzbekistan's urban transportation network is reliable and affordable, with ride-hailing services widely available throughout major cities.



ARRIVAL AND ONBOARDING SUPPORT

The program aims to ensure a smooth transition for all international teachers arriving in Uzbekistan.

Support provided before and after arrival includes:








- Visa and work permit guidance
- Pre-arrival coordination
- Airport arrival assistance
- Accommodation preparation before arrival
- Local registration support
- Assistance opening local bank accounts and obtaining SIM cards
- Ongoing support from program coordinators

Teachers will receive guidance throughout the onboarding process to help them settle comfortably into their new environment and workplace.

COST OF LIVING AND SAVINGS POTENTIAL

One of the major advantages of living and working in Uzbekistan is the affordable cost of living. With accommodation provided by the program, teachers are often able to enjoy a comfortable lifestyle while saving a significant portion of their monthly salary.

Depending on lifestyle and location, many teachers are able to save between USD 800–1500 per month.

THE TIMELINE OF EVENTS

RECRUITMENT TIMELINE

Application Process Overview

Step 1 — Application Submission

Candidates submit an online application through the designated recruitment platform/link.

Step 2 — Initial Review

Applications are reviewed by the recruitment team. Suitable candidates may be contacted for additional information.

Step 3 — Interview Stage

Interviews are generally arranged within approximately 1–2 weeks following successful application review.

Step 4 — Offer and Contract

Successful candidates typically receive confirmation and contract documentation within 1–2 weeks after the interview process.

Step 5 — Documentation and Visa Preparation

Work permit and onboarding documentation is prepared with support from the program team.

Step 6 — Travel and Arrival

International flights are arranged and teachers receive pre-arrival guidance before travelling to Uzbekistan.

Step 7 — Settlement and School Placement

Upon arrival, teachers are supported through onboarding, accommodation settlement, and introduction to their assigned school and local coordinators.



CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree or above in English, TESOL, Education, or a related field. Or BA in any subject + CELTA/DELTA/TESOL
- At least two years of experience teaching English in international settings
- Demonstrated understanding of, or strong interest in, intercultural communication; willingness and ability to adapt to multicultural environments and a foreign public education system.
- Native English speaker (from UK, US, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand or South Africa)

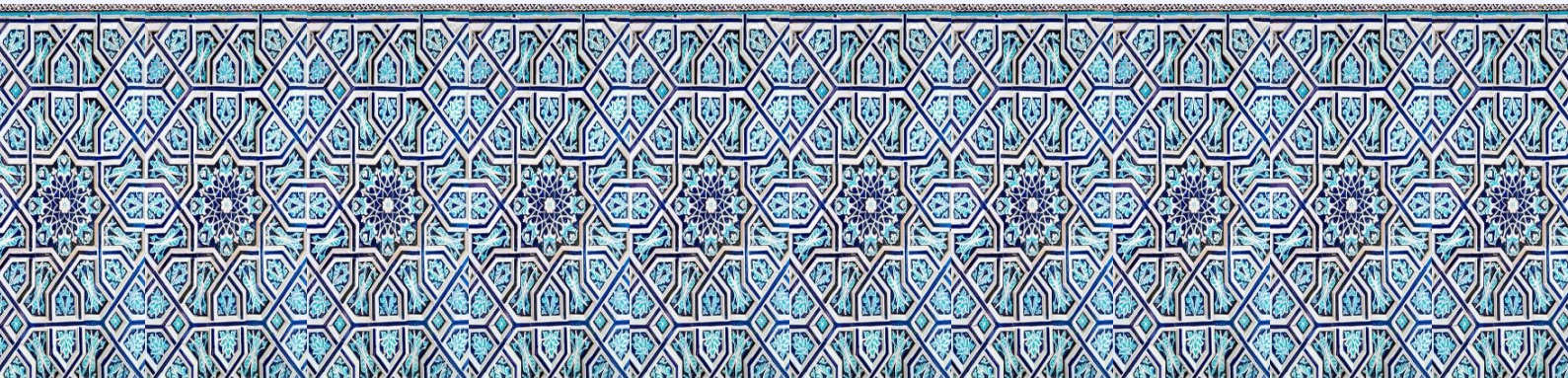
